Matthew Seaver BSc MA MIAI is a senior archaeologist and project manager with CRDS Ltd. Matthew attained his primary degree (BSc) in Archaeology from Bradford University in 1995. He obtained his 1st class MA from UCD in 1997 winning the Ruadhri de Valera Memorial Prize. Matthew joined CRDS in 2004 having worked with a number of commercial archaeological companies since 1997, obtaining archaeological excavation license eligibility in 1998. In the period 1998 – 2004, he excavated a number of high profile sites, including at Laughanstown, Co. Dublin and Platin, Co. Louth.



During his time with CRDS, his most notable work has been the excavation of the Early Medieval Complex at Raystown, Co. Meath. Matthews work on this site was recognised by the winning of the 2005 British Festival of Science Award for Excellence in Archaeological Research. He is a professional member of the Institute of Archaeologists of Ireland, and a member of the Royal Society of Antiquaries and the Kilkenny Archaeological Society.
